Government of India has decided to constitute a Committee to carry out a comprehensive review of the existing Rate Structure for DAVP Advertisements and to suggest a new Rate Structure formula to be effective from 01.01.2009. The constitution of the Committee will be as follows:

i) AS&FA, Min. of I&B	-Chairman
ii) Economic Advisor, Min. of I&B	-Member
iii) Advisor Cost/Representative of Advisor Cost, Min. of Finance iv) DG/Director, DAVP v) JS(P&A), Min. of I&B vi) ADG(Advtg.), DAVP	-Member -Member -Member -Member Secretary

- The terms of reference of the new Restructure Committee would be as under :-
 - To carry out a comprehensive review of existing rate (a) structure for DAVP advertisements and to suggest a new rate structure formula.

Whether combined rates to multi edition newspapers are feasible in place of separate rate for each edition.

- Whether it is feasible to replace cost and circulation (c) based DAVP rates by commercial card rates. comparative advantages and disadvantages,
- The new Committee in the discharge of its functions (d) may analyze and study all the factors affecting advertisement rates in-depth and recommend suitable all the varieties and types for rates advertisements/papers.
- The new Committee may also interact with State (e) Governments and other concerned organizations and its deliberations will cover all related factors, which may have bearing on the advertisement rates.
- 3. The committee may submit its report within a period of one month.
